All drivers must have an approved transportation form on file in the school office. All pupils transported by parents will be required to wear seat belts and/or appropriate booster seats that are required by current state law. Pupils will be expected to share in the expense involved. Participants in school-related activities, such as field trips, must have attended classes on the day of that activity.

Vision and Hearing Screenings



Zion Lutheran School will be hosting a vision/screening assessment for students in grades Kindergarten, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 5th, and 7th on Thursday, November 30 from 8-12 noon. It is a free service offered to our families in those grades. The assessment will be completed by a trained audiologist and vision screeners contracted by us through 27J school district. If your child currently wears glasses, please be sure he/she wears them on the day of the testing.

As parents you will receive results of the assessment for your child(ren). Assessment results are simply informational for you the parent. What you choose to do with them is up to you. Having your child screened does not bind you to any requirements to follow-up with a specialist unless you choose to seek one.
